- 7 1. The Office of Federal Contract Compliance, pursuant to 41 C.F.R. 60,
8 requires federal grant recipients to develop and implement an affirmative
9 action plan.
- 10 2. Initiative 200 allows for public employers to establish affirmative
11 action plans to meet federal grant requirements.
- 12 3. King County receives federal grants directly from the federal
13 government and indirectly through state and local agencies.


