We, the elector-residents of Merganser precinct in the Black Diamond-Lake Sawyer area of Southeast King County, hereby respectfully request that the King County Council create a NO SHOOTING ZONE adjacent to our neighborhoods.

We petition that a No Shooting Area be approved for the following area:


All that portion of Section 15, Township 21 north, Range 6 east, W.M. lying westerly of the corporate city limits of Black Diamond.

### Reason for petition:

For many years, hearing the sound of firearms being discharged on the properties identified above has caused concern because it is close to our homes and roads, and in the woods where we enjoy walks. This concern turns to fear, however, each time an area resident sees a new bullet hole or experiences hearing the distinct whiz of a bullet going past them and their family on their own property. In spite of No Target Shooting signs being posted by Plum Creek Timber, this past year we have observed an alarming increase of indiscriminate and prolonged shooting of firearms, some which sound like automatic weapons, at all hours of the day and night and sometimes very close to our homes. Despite numerous calls to 911 and the cooperative efforts of Plum Creek Timber, this problem not only persists, but is escalating.

Please grant this request to provide safety to our neighborhoods and give the Sheriff deputies a tool of enforcement.
