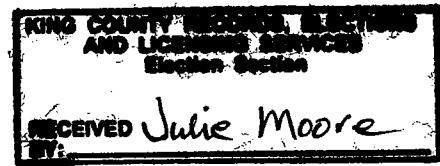

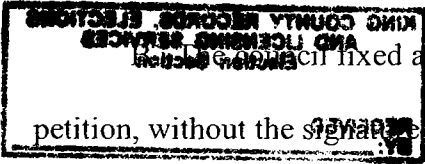
1 AN ORDINANCE establishing February 7, 2006, as the
2 date of a special election on the question of creating a
3 public hospital district on Vashon Island; establishing and
4 defining the boundary lines of the proposed public hospital
5 district; and determining the number of commissioners of
6 the proposed public hospital district and the manner of their
7 election; and declaring an emergency.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Findings:

12 A. 1. On August 25, 2005, a petition for the formation a new public hospital
13 district in King County encompassing all territory of Vashon-Maury Island was filed with
14 the King County director of the records, elections and licensing services division. The
15 King County director of the records, elections and licensing services division has
16 examined the signatures on the petition, compared them with the voter registration

17 records of the King County records, election and licensing services division, and certified
18 their sufficiency in compliance with RCW 70.44.020 and RCW 70.44.030.



19 The council fixed a date for a hearing on the petition and published the
20 petition, without the signatures, together with a notice stating the time of the hearing, in
21 the Vashon Island Beachcomber on October 12, 2005, and October 19, 2005, in
22 compliance with RCW 70.44.030.

23 C. The council held a public hearing on the petition in compliance with RCW
24 70.44.030.

25 SECTION 2. The proposed public hospital district shall be known as "King
26 County Public Hospital District No. 5."

27 SECTION 3. The boundary lines of the proposed King County Public Hospital
28 District No. 5 shall be as follows:

29 The territory to be included in King County Public Hospital District No. 5
30 is bounded from the point on Vashon Heights at the Northeast corner of
31 Government Lot 1, Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 3 East W.M., by
32 the meander line of the low water marks of Puget Sound, starting East,
33 thence South around adjoining Maury Island, thence South around the
34 Southern tip of Vashon Island, thence North to the original point of
35 beginning, following the meander line of low water mark of Puget Sound
36 at all times, and including all docks, wharves, and residences attached to
37 said islands, which may protrude beyond the low water meander line.

38 SECTION 4. Pursuant to RCW 29A.04.321 and 70.44.020, it is hereby deemed
39 that an emergency exists for purposes of calling a special election. The King County

40 director of the records, elections and licensing services division is hereby requested to
41 assume jurisdiction to call and conduct a special election and submit to the registered
42 voters within the subject area of the proposition as set forth in section 3 of this ordinance.
43 The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to transmit these propositions
44 to the director of the records, elections and licensing services division in substantially the
45 following form, with such additions, deletions or modifications in the ballot title as may
46 be required for the propositions listed below by the King County prosecutor:

47 PUBLIC HOSPITAL DISTRICT NO. 5

48 KING COUNTY WASHINGTON

49 The King County Council adopted Ordinance No. 15313 concerning a
50 proposition to form King County Public Hospital District No. 5. This
51 proposition would authorize the formation of a new public hospital district
52 having the powers and duties provided in RCW 70.44.060. The new
53 public hospital district would encompass all territory of Vashon-Maury
54 Island and would be governed by a board of commissioners composed of
55 five positions, all of whom would be elected on an at-large basis.


58 SECTION 5. The board of commissioners of the King County Public Hospital
59 District No. 5 shall be composed of five positions to be elected on an at-large basis. The
60 initial commissioners for all five positions shall be elected at the February 7, 2006,
61 election.

62 SECTION 6. The director of the records, elections and licensing services division
63 is hereby authorized and requested to prepare and distribute a local voters' pamphlet,
64 pursuant to K.C.C. 1.10.010, for the special election called for in this ordinance, the cost
65 of the pamphlet to be included as part of the cost of the special election.




