8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.34.050 are  
10 each hereby amended as follows:

11 **Compensation.**


12 A. For each six-hour day devoted to official work of the board, each member and  
13 each hearing examiner employed by the board thereof shall receive a per diem allowance  
14 of two hundred fifty dollars except that a per diem allowance of one hundred (~~twenty-~~  
15 ~~five~~) fifty dollars shall be paid for official board work of more than four hours but less  
16 than six hours.

17 B. Members of the board assigned parking stalls shall pay parking fees as  
18 provided for in K.C.C. chapter 3.32 unless exempted from payment by ordinance.




