5	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
6	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of South 108th
7	Street hereinafter described.
8	2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies serving
9	the area and has been advised that easements have either been obtained or are not
10	required within the vacation area.
11	3. The department of transportation records indicates that King County has not
12	been maintaining South 108th Street. The records indicate that no public funds
13	have been expended for its acquisition.
14	4. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the right of
15	way useless as part of the King County road system and believes the public would
16	benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

17	5. The right of way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with K.C.C.
18	14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the
19	assessed value of the subject right of way, which was determined from records of
20	the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$12,375.77 from the
21	petitioner.
22	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was
23	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 11th day of October
24	2006.
25	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the
26	council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King
27	County to grant said petition.
28	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
29	SECTION 1. The council, on the effective date of this ordinance, hereby vacates
30	and abandons that portion of South 108th Street as conveyed to King County by the
31	recording of the Plat of Glendale Country Club No. 3 recorded in Volume 62 of Plats,
32	Page 94, records of King County, Washington as described below:
33	That portion of the southerly half of South 108th Street right of way
34	abutting and adjacent to Lot 1, Block A, of Glendale Country Club No. 3

recorded in Volume 62 of Plats, Page 94, records of King County,

Washington.

- 4. Maps showing the vicinity of the proposed vacation and the specific area to be vacated appear in the hearing record as exhibit nos. 7 and 10.
- 5. The subject right-of-way is not currently opened for public use, has never been constructed or maintained by the public, and is not used informally for access to any property.
- 6. Vacation of the right-of-way would have no adverse effect on the provision of access and fire and emergency services to the abutting property and surrounding area.
- 7. The right-of-way is not necessary for the present or future road system for travel or utilities purposes.

8. No easements are necessary to be retained for the construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.

9. The compensation required by law to be paid as a condition precedent to the vacation of this road has been deposited with King County.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL
AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before November 3, 2006. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before November 13, 2006.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.


