1 AN ORDINANCE reflecting the revised due date for  
2 submission to council of the veterans and human services  
3 levy annual report to July 1, 2009; and amending  
4 Ordinance 15632, Section 5.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 15632, Section 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 By June 1, 2007, and each year thereafter through 2011, with the exception of  
9 2009, when the annual report is due July 1, the department of community and human  
10 services or its successor shall prepare and the executive submit to the council and  
11 regional policy committee for review and acceptance by motion an annual progress report  
12 on the implementation of the King County Veterans and Human Services Levy Service  
13 Improvement Plan.

14 A. The initial progress report shall include:

15 1. A description of how service improvements have been procured to date and  
16 the status of service and project implementation;

17           2. A detailed evaluation plan laying out the process, content, schedule and  
18 annual report format for implementation, provider performance and outcome evaluation  
19 for each of the service and capital improvement areas;

20           3. An updated financial plan showing actual and projected revenue and  
21 expenditures for the veterans and regional human services funds for each year of the levy  
22 and explaining changes from the previous year's financial plan; and

23           4. A report or reports from the oversight boards regarding their assessment of  
24 progress and any recommendations they may have for improvement of levy program  
25 operations and results.

26           B. Subsequent progress reports shall include the annual evaluation report, the  
27 updated financial plan with an explanation of changes and the report from the oversight  
28

29 boards and shall address action taken to correct poor performance and adjust or  
30 reprioritize strategies that do not achieve desired results.




