1 AN ORDINANCE relating to transportation concurrency;
2 adopting the new transportation concurrency map;
3 amending Ordinance 14050, Section 10, as amended, and
4 K.C.C. 14.70.230 and repealing Ordinance 16266,
5 Attachment A.

6 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 7 1. On October 6, 2008, the council amended the transportation
8 concurrency program to improve the effectiveness and streamline its
9 operation by adopting a travel time based concurrency map to be used for
10 both residential and nonresidential development proposals.
11 2. K.C.C. 14.70.270 requires the concurrency map to be updated annually
12 and submitted to the council as part of the budget process.

13 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

14 SECTION 1. Ordinance 14050, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.230
15 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

16 A. The department shall perform a concurrency analysis and test for each travel
17 shed to determine whether areas within the travel sheds are concurrent. The test for each
18 area shall be based on the level of service analysis results for the entire travel shed.

19 Areas shall be deemed concurrent if eighty-five percent of the arterials within their travel
20 shed meet level of service standards.

21 B. The department shall use the concurrency map currently in effect when
22 making a concurrency determination for a proposed development. The concurrency map
23 displayed in Attachment A to (~~Ordinance 16266~~) this ordinance is adopted as the
24 official concurrency map for King County. The department shall make a determination
25 of concurrency according to the status indicated on the adopted concurrency map for the
26 area in which the proposed development is located. Attachment B to Ordinance 16266 is
27 a map indicating the boundaries of the travel sheds.



Ordinance 16763 was introduced on 11/23/2009 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 2/22/2010, by the following vote:





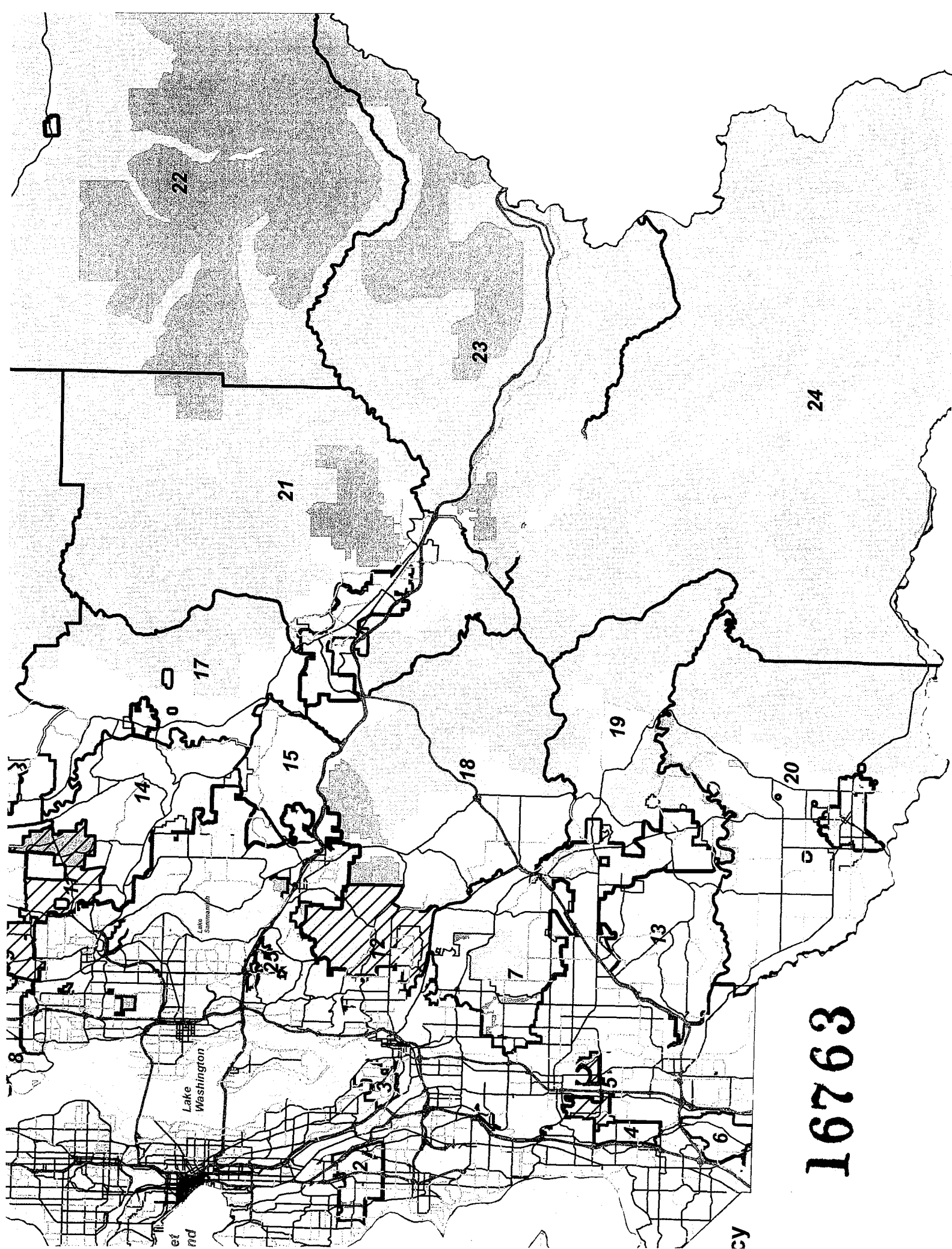
