1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle-King County
2 department of public health; establishing fees under K.C.C.
3 2.99.030 for certain documents and for certain notary
4 services to align revenues to associated costs; and adding a
5 new chapter to K.C.C. Title 4.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. A. Section 3 of this ordinance establishes a fee for a person who
8 requests and receives notary services from the director of the Seattle-King County
9 department of public health in accordance with chapters 26.26, 70.08 and 70.58 RCW.

10 B. The fee is established under K.C.C. 2.99.030.

11 SECTION 2. Section 3 of this ordinance should constitute a new chapter on vital
12 statistics fees in K.C.C. Title 4.

13 NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. A person who receives notary services from the
14 director of the Seattle-King County department of public health in accordance with

15 chapters 26.26 RCW and 70.08 RCW shall be charged a fee of eight dollars.


16 SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2011.




