1	AN ORDINANCE relating to emergency jail housing
2	authorizing the extension of an emergency jail housing
3	agreement for temporary detention services between King
4	County and the Pierce county sheriff's office.
5	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
6	SECTION 1. Findings:
7	A. King County department of adult and juvenile detention ("DAJD") has a need
8	for options to house inmates elsewhere in an emergency situation.
9	B. In 2009, DAJD and the Pierce county sheriff's office ("PCSO") entered into an
10	agreement to provide housing to assist DAJD in an emergent situation.
11	C. DAJD and PCSO have identified a plan and cost reimbursement for
12	emergency housing.
13	D. The agreement may be reciprocal for PCSO and if needed, both parties shall
14	negotiate terms.
15	E. All elements of the existing agreement dated October 27, 2009, renewed on
16	October 27, 2010, shall remain in effect until December 31, 2012, except that the
17	maximum number of available beds is reduced from one hundred sixty-eight to eighty-
18	four.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT #002 TO Contract 77170 — Dated 11/1/2009 For Emergency Jail Housing

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by Pierce County and King County.

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into an agreement dated 11/01/2009 for emergency jail bed space,

WHEREAS, the-parties desire to amend the agreement in consideration of the mutual benefits and advantages to be derived by each of the parties,

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

- 1. Contract term to be extended for one additional year from 1/1/2012 to 12/31/2012.
- 2. Jail housing limited during this term to one unit, 84 beds. Section 4. (a) of the agreement is modified as follows:

"In the event of an emergency Pierce County agrees to house King County inmates in Pierce County correctional facilities. Housing shall not exceed 84 beds and there shall be no minimum. These inmates will be under the supervision of corrections officers from King County."

All other terms and conditions of the agreement and all supplements and modifications thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
