1           AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive  
2           to enter into amendments to interlocal cooperation  
3           agreements with the cities of Bothell and Seattle for the  
4           disbursement of conservation futures tax levy funds  
5           appropriated under Ordinance 17349.

6           STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 7           1. King County conservation futures tax levy funds are collected  
8           throughout King County as a dedicated portion of the property tax for the  
9           acquisition of open space and resource lands.
- 10          2. Ordinance 14714 established procedures for the annual allocation of  
11          conservation futures tax levy funds, which direct the conservation futures  
12          citizens' committee to make funding recommendations to the King County  
13          executive to consider for inclusion in the annual budget ordinance.
- 14          3. The executive received and considered the conservation futures  
15          citizens' committee funding recommendations and included them in the  
16          second fiscal quarter 2012 annual budget supplemental ordinance,  
17          Ordinance 17349, in which the King County council appropriated 2012  
18          conservation futures funds or modified project scopes for the city open  
19          space projects listed and described in Attachment B to this ordinance.

20           5. King County desires to disburse conservation futures funds to the cities  
21           of Bothell and Seattle, and to do so it must sign conservation futures  
22           interlocal cooperation agreements or amend existing conservation futures  
23           interlocal agreements with these jurisdictions.

24           6. The county and the cities are authorized to enter into an interlocal  
25           agreement pursuant to chapter 39.34 RCW, the Interlocal Cooperation  
26           Act.

27           BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

28           SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into and  
29           execute amendments to interlocal cooperation agreements containing language,  
30           substantially similar to that in Attachment A to this ordinance, necessary for the

31 disbursement of conservation futures tax levy funds appropriated under Ordinances  
32 17349.

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES  
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF \_\_\_\_\_  
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

**Preamble**

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF \_\_\_\_\_ and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the \_\_\_\_ day of (Month), (Year), as previously amended.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

**Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals**

A paragraph is hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for a Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocation for the \_\_\_\_\_ Acquisition, and hereafter reads:

**Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County**

The first two sentences of this article are amended to include references to Attachment \_\_, which lists a 201\_ Conservation Futures Levy proceeds allocation for the \_\_\_\_\_ Acquisition Project:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through \_\_, to be

used for the Projects listed in Attachments A through \_\_. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through \_\_. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

**AMENDMENT 4: Attachment \_\_**

The Attachments to the interlocal agreement are hereby amended by adding Attachment \_\_, which is hereby attached to the interlocal agreement, incorporated therein and made a part thereof.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.

## Conservation Futures (CFT) Project Descriptions

### Suburban City CFT Projects:

#### 1047239 Bothell - North Creek Woods

\$181,694 in Conservation Futures funds will be reallocated to this project from the completed Lake Forest Park Towne Center Park project, which has unanticipated project funds not necessary for project completion. This project will acquire additional woodland property in the headwaters of North Creek, immediately west of Interstate 405 and highly visible from the interstate.

### Seattle Projects:

#### 1047216 Greenwood/Phinney Urban Center Park

This project received \$500,000 in Conservation Futures funding from King County with the understanding that Seattle would choose from among three sites in the Greenwood/Phinney Ridge neighborhood on Greenwood Avenue, which is underserved with open space, for final approval by King County. This action will approve Seattle's selection of a site on Greenwood Avenue at 81<sup>st</sup> Street, directly across 81<sup>st</sup> Street from the recently-constructed neighborhood branch of the Seattle Public Library.

#### 1112180 University District Urban Center Park

\$72,846 in Conservation Futures funds will be reallocated to this project from the recently-completed University District/Denny Triangle UCP project. That older project has a similar goal of acquiring open space in the University District neighborhood, which is underserved with open space, and has a need for additional funding for project completion.

#### 1047211 International District Urban Center Park

This project received Conservation Futures funding from King County with the understanding that Seattle would work with local community leaders and groups in the International District, which is underserved with open space, to identify an open space site for final approval by King County. This action confirms Seattle's selection of a site on Jackson Street in the International District, about one half block north of 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
