1 AN ORDINANCE making corrections and updating county  
2 code sections relating to county funds; amending  
3 Ordinance 17752, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C.  
4 4A.200.268, as amended, adding new sections to K.C.C.  
5 chapter 4A.200.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 17752, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.200.268

8 are hereby amended to read as follows:

9 A. There is hereby created the emergency medical services fund.

10 B. The fund shall be a first tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

11 C. The director of the department of public health shall be the manager of the  
12 fund.

13 D. All receipts in the fund shall be used for the following purposes: ((of))

14 1. ((a))Accounting for the proceeds of the property tax levy approved by the  
15 voters of King County on November 5, 2013, in excess of the levy limitation contained in  
16 chapter 84.55 RCW. The six-year levy, commencing in 2014, was approved by the  
17 voters for the express purpose of paying costs associated with the provision of emergency  
18 medical care or emergency medical services, as authorized by 84.52.069 RCW;

19           2. Accounting for grant funds received by emergency medical services division  
20 or accounting for grants related to research, evaluation, education, and provision of  
21 emergency medical services and restricted to the uses specified in the grant; and

22           3. Accounting for funds received from other revenue sources, including  
23 entrepreneurial programs and patent revenues.

24           E. The fund shall be considered a fund through the life of the levy approved in  
25 2013 and any successive levies, unless otherwise required by ordinance.

26           NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 4A.200  
27 a new section to read as follows:

28           A. There is hereby created the environmental health fund.

29           B. The fund shall be a second tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

30           C. The director of the department of public health shall be the manager of the  
31 fund.

32           D. The fund shall account for the proceeds of receipts from federal, state and  
33 local sources, including license and permit fees administered by environmental health,  
34 and shall be deposited in the fund.

35 E. The fund shall be used to support environmental health activities and related  
36 administration.
