1 AN ORDINANCE renaming the children and family
2 services fund and shifting revenue sources related to this
3 fund; amending Ordinance 15961 Section 2, as amended,
4 and K.C.C. 4A.200.170, Ordinance 5220, Section 2, as
5 amended, and K.C.C. 6.80.020 and Ordinance 8753,
6 Section 7, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.090, recodifying
7 K.C.C. 4A.200.170 and adding a new section to K.C.C.
8 chapter 4A.200.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. K.C.C. 4A.200.170, as amended by this ordinance, is hereby
11 recodified as a new section in K.C.C. chapter 4A.200.

12 SECTION 2. Ordinance 15961, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.200.170
13 are hereby amended to read as follows:

14 A. There is hereby created the ((~~children and families services~~)) community
15 services operating fund.

16 B. The fund shall be a first tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

17 C. The director of the department of community and human services shall be the
18 manager of the fund.

19 D. The fund shall be used to collect revenue from state, local and other funding
20 sources and to expend direct service and related administration dollars to support a broad
21 array of human services for children and families to help them achieve self-sufficiency.

22 SECTION 3. Ordinance 5220, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 6.80.020 are
23 hereby amended to read as follows:

24 The county shall distribute the marriage license fees as follows. For each license
25 sold:

26 A. King County fees:

27 1. ~~(((\$8.00))~~ \$23.00 - King County general fund (RCW 36.18.010), of which
28 \$15.00 is to be used to fund family services (RCW 26.04.160);

29 2. \$8.00 - King County family court fund (RCW 26.12.220), to be used to pay
30 for expenses of family court under chapter 25.12 RCW; and

31 3. \$2.00 - King County records preservations fund (RCW 36.22.170, to be
32 deposited in the recorder's operational and maintenance fund for ongoing preservation of
33 historical documents; and

34 ~~((4. \$15.00 - King County family services fund (RCW 26.04.160), to be used to~~
35 ~~fund family services. Fees collected in K.C.C. 6.80.020A.1. through 6.80.020A.4. above~~
36 ~~shall be deposited in the same manner as other county funds and shall be maintained in a~~
37 ~~separate account; and))~~

38 B. State of Washington fees:

39 1. \$10.00 - State of Washington Displaced Homemaker program (RCW
40 36.18.010), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer and deposited in the state
41 general fund for the purposes of the displaced homemaker act, chapter 28B.04 RCW;

42 2. \$5.00 - State of Washington Child Abuse program (RCW 36.18.010), to be
43 transmitted monthly to the state treasurer for use and support of the prevention of child
44 abuse and neglect activities;

45 3. \$2.00 - State of Washington Records Preservation program (RCW
46 36.22.170), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer who shall distribute such
47 funds to each county treasurer within the state in July of each year in accordance with the
48 formula described in RCW 36.22.190 for ongoing preservation of historical documents of
49 all county offices and departments; and

50 4. \$2.00 - Surcharge for archives and records management (RCW 36.22.175), to
51 be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer for deposit in the archives and records
52 management account.

53 SECTION 4. Ordinance 8753, Section 7, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.090 are
54 hereby amended to read as follows:

55 All revenues derived from parking fees shall be distributed as follows:

56 A. Applicable local and state taxes;

57 B. An allocation to cover rent payments or debt service payments for the Goat
58 Hill parking garage and pro-rated rent for the parking portion of the Chinook Building;

59 C. It is the intent of the council to ~~((annually))~~ biennially, during the budget
60 process, identify a portion of the revenue going to the current expense fund to be
61 transferred to the major maintenance reserve fund to support major maintenance projects
62 at the garage and other parking facilities, taking into account the major maintenance
63 model and financial plan;

64 D. An allocation to the facilities management division of the department of
65 executive services's internal service fund to reimburse the fund for expenses associated
66 with the operation of the parking program;

67 E. An allocation to the community services operating fund for support of health
68 and human services activities sufficient to increase the allocation from 2004 levels at the

69 local consumer price index; and

70 F. The residual revenues distributed to the current expense fund.
