1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Vashon-Maury Island  
2 groundwater protection committee; and amending  
3 Ordinance 14214, Section 8, as amended, and K.C.C.  
4 9.14.070.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 14124, Section 8, as amended, and K.C.C. 9.14.070 are  
7 each hereby amended to read as follows:

8 A. The Vashon-Maury island groundwater protection committee is hereby  
9 created and shall continue in existence until December 31, 2017. ~~((The Vashon-Maury  
10 island groundwater protection committee shall be referred to as the “groundwater  
11 protection committee” or “the committee” throughout this section.))~~

12 ~~((A.))~~ B. The ~~((groundwater protection))~~ committee members shall be selected  
13 from within the Vashon-Maury island groundwater management plan area and shall  
14 consist of the following ~~((representatives))~~:

- 15 1. ~~((One))~~ Three representatives ~~((from the groundwater advisory committee))~~  
16 who are Vashon-Maury island residents;
- 17 2. One representative from water purveyors;
- 18 3. ~~((Two))~~ One representative~~((s))~~ from ~~((sewer and water utilities and  
19 associations))~~ interests representing water supply or wastewater management;

- 20           4. One representative from residential exempt well ~~((users))~~ owners;
- 21           5. One representative from ~~((business owners))~~ island commercial and industrial
- 22 interests;
- 23           6. One representative from commercial agriculturists;
- 24           7. One ~~((representative who is a resident of the Vashon-Maury Island~~
- 25 ~~community))~~ livestock owner; and

- 26           8. ~~((One representative from chambers of commerce; and~~
- 27 ~~9.))~~ One representative from local environmental organizations.

28           ~~((B.))~~ C. The county shall invite each of the tribal nations with federally

29 recognized rights within the Vashon-Maury island groundwater management area to

30 recommend candidates for the committee. The committee shall include a representative

31 from each tribal nation with federally recognized rights within the Vashon-Maury island

32 groundwater management area, if the tribal nation provides to the county a candidate for

33 appointment to the committee.

34           ~~((C.))~~ D. Each county abutting the Vashon-Maury island groundwater

35 management plan area boundary shall be requested to provide to the county a candidate

36 for appointment to the committee on an advisory, nonvoting basis.

37           ~~((D.))~~ E. The Seattle-King County department of public health and the

38 Washington state departments of Ecology and Health shall be requested to provide to the


39 county a candidate for appointment to the committee on an advisory, nonvoting basis.

40            (~~E~~) F. Each member of the committee shall coordinate internally with the  
41 entity the member represents.


