6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 12917, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.640.010 are
7 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 education and release and)) electronic ((home detention)) monitoring program are hereby

73 SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2019.
