1 AN ORDINANCE extending the purpose of the veterans,  
2 seniors and human services levy fund; amending the name,  
3 and amending Ordinance 18615, Section 1, and K.C.C.  
4 4A.200.747.

5 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

6 1. In July 2017, Ordinance 18555 placed a six-year levy lid lift on the  
7 ballot. King County voters approved the 2018-2023 veterans, seniors and  
8 human services levy in November 2017 to plan, provide, administer, and  
9 evaluate a wide range of regional health and human services and capital  
10 facilities for veterans and military servicemembers and their respective  
11 families, seniors and their caregivers, and vulnerable populations.

12 2. In 2018, Ordinance 18615 created the veterans, seniors and human  
13 services levy fund to account for the proceeds of the revenue from the levy  
14 lid lift for the express purpose of paying costs consistent with Ordinance  
15 18555.

16 3. In 2023, Ordinance 19604 placed a six-year renewal of the levy lid lift  
17 on the ballot. King County voters approved Proposition No. 1 on August  
18 1, 2023, authorizing the renewal of the levy, continuing for 2024-2029 to  
19 fund capital facilities and services for veterans and military  
20 servicemembers, and their respective families; seniors and their

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21 caregivers; and resilient populations susceptible to reduced health,  
22 housing, financial, or social stability outcomes.

23 4. Ordinance 19604, Section 3 requires proceeds from the levy to be  
24 deposited into a dedicated subfund of the veterans, seniors and human  
25 services levy fund, or its successor.

26 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

27 SECTION 1. Ordinance 18615, Section 1, and K.C.C. 4A.200.747 are hereby  
28 amended as follows.

29 A. There is hereby created the veterans, seniors, and human services levy fund.

30 B. The fund shall be a first tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

31 C. The director of the department of community and human services shall be the  
32 manager of the fund.

33 D. The fund shall account for the proceeds of the property tax ((levy)) levies in  
34 excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW that ((was approved in  
35 accordance with Ordinance 18555. The six-year levy commencing in 2018, is for the  
36 express purpose of paying costs consistent with Ordinance 18555-)) were approved by the  
37 voters in King County in 2017 and 2023 in accordance with Ordinances 18555 and  
38 19604, and any successive levies, unless otherwise required by ordinance. The levy

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- 39 proceeds are for the express purpose of paying eligible expenditures as provided in
- 40 Ordinances 18555 and 19604, and any successive levy ordinances.




