1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
 2 approximately 79.90 acres of land into the Soos
 3 Creek Water and Sewer District, known as the
 4 LakePointe Annexation, for the purpose of sewer
 5 service.

6 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

7 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of approximately 79.90
 8 acres of land into the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District, known as the
 9 LakePointe Annexation, for the purpose of sewer service was filed with
 10 the county council on October 31, 2023.

11 2. The LakePointe Annexation area is within the Soos Creek Water and
 12 Sewer District's sewer service area.

13 6. The Soos Creek Water and Sewer District filed a determination of
 14 nonsignificance on the proposed annexation dated July 6, 2023.

15 7. The Soos Creek Water and Sewer District approved the proposed
 16 annexation in Resolution No. 3817-S, passed on July 26, 2023.

17 8. The utilities technical review committee reviewed the Soos Creek
 18 Water and Sewer District sewer comprehensive plan and found that the
 19 plan met the criteria for approval. The county approved the most recent
 20 plan for the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District in 2014, as part of

Ordinance 19737

21 Ordinance 17821.

22 9. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has
23 considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.

24 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

25 SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 79.90 acres of land into the Soos
26 Creek Water and Sewer District, known as the LakePointe Annexation, for the purpose of
27 sewer service, described in Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this
28 proposed annexation is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.

29 SECTION 2. The Soos Creek Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity
30 to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

31 SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval


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32 or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service
33 to this annexation area.

A DESCRIPTION OF THE AREA SOUGHT TO BE ANNEXED IS AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 6 East. W.M., in King County, Washington, said point being on the existing corporate boundary for Soos Creek Water & Sewer District;

Thence southerly along the East line of said Southwest quarter, said East line being the existing corporate boundary for Soos Creek Water & Sewer District, to the Southeast corner of said Southwest quarter;

Thence westerly along the South line of said Southwest quarter, said South line being the existing corporate boundary for Soos Creek Water & Sewer District, to the Southwest corner of said Southwest quarter;

Thence northerly along the West line of said Southwest quarter, said West line being the existing corporate boundary for Soos Creek Water & Sewer District, to the Northwest corner of said South half of the Southwest quarter;

Thence easterly along the North line of said South half to said Northeast corner of the South half, said point being on the existing corporate boundary for Soos Creek Water & Sewer District, and the Point of Beginning of this description.
