

IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SOUTH 288th STREET (PACIFIC HIGHWAY SOUTH TO 51st AVENUE SOUTH) County Road.

Order of Establishment Survey No. 4-21-4-27

In the matter of the establishment of the South 288th Street (Pacific Highway South to 51st Avenue South) Council county road the Board finds as follows:

First. That the Motion No. 96 therefore was \* passed on the 15th day of September, 19 69, and the County Engineer was duly directed to examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

Second. That on the 10th day of September, 1969, the County Engineer filed in the office of the Council Board his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 27th day of October, 1969, was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

Third. That the Council Board having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL BOARD that the South 288th Street (Pacific Highway South to 51st Avenue South) Road be established as follows:

Beginning on the North line of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., at a point 237.88 feet easterly on the northwest corner of said Section 4; thence along said north line in an easterly direction a distance of 10,294.26 feet to a terminus at the northeast corner of Section 3, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., said terminus being Engineer's Station 102+94.26 at the intersection of South 288th Street and 51st Avenue South.

10,294.26 feet = 1.95 miles
