

AN ORDINANCE adjusting and correcting certain omissions and errors in the 1970 Budget and amending Ordinance No. 239 and Ordinance No. 238 relating to the appropriation of monies and the adoption of the 1970 Budget for King County, Washington.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:


SECTION 1: The appropriation of monies for certain budget classifications established in Section 2 of this Ordinance is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2: The following pages, copies of which are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, shall hereby amend the document entitled "1970 Budget, King County, Washington," Ordinance No. 239, and Ordinance No. 238 and shall be incorporated therein.

SECTION 3: The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the support of County Government and its existing institutions.


