

An Ordinance establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation to the City of Renton of territory known as "Talbot Hill" area.

WHEREAS the City of Renton by Resolution No. 1637 has determined that the best interests and general welfare of Renton would be served by this annexation of unincorporated territory contiguous thereto as described in said Resolution No. 1637; and,

WHEREAS said resolution does further satisfy the provisions of RCW 35.13.015 and prays for the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein upon the question of annexation; and,

WHEREAS said resolution further provides for assumption of a proportionate share of the City of Renton's present indebtedness and adoption of the City of Renton's Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS said proposed annexation has previously been heard and approved before the Boundary Review Board pursuant to Chapter 36.93.100,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the King County Council that the question of annexation, the question of assumption of indebtedness, and the question of adoption of the Comprehensive Plan be placed on the ballot for vote by the qualified voters residing within the territory sought to be annexed on May 19, 1970.

PASSED by the Council at a regular meeting thereof on the 23rd day of March, 1970.
