AN ORDINANCE amending King County Districting (Zoning) Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the District (Zoning) map thereof Reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of WILLIAM E. RUTH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. WILLIAM E. RUTH petitioned on December 23, 1969 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS 9600 to S-R and this application was assigned Department of Planning No. P 69-225.

Section 2. The report and recommendation of the Department of Planning was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on March 10, 1970, and hearing was held by the Examiner on this matter on March 17, 1970. The attached report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on April 3, 1970.

Section 3. The legal description of the property hereby reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

Section 4. The King County Council does hereby reclassify that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B, above to S-R as shown on Appendices A and B and directs that Area Map No. W 24-22-5 be modified to so designate.
