Business Changes

Please complete the *Business Change Form* at esd.wa.gov/tax-forms if this occurred:

- Address changed
- Business closed, merged, or sold
- You no longer have employees and would like to close your account

Definitions

These terms appear on the billing statement:

- Amount due - What you owe, including any tax, interest, penalties and legal fees.
- Oldest original due date - The due date for the oldest quarter that you have not yet paid in full.
- Additional charges accrue on - We charge penalties and interest if your payment is received after this date.
- Statement closed date - Payments and reports received after this date will appear on your next statement.

How we apply payments

Payments received without a tax report are applied in this order, beginning with the *oldest quarter*:

- Audit and collection costs
- Penalties for giving false information
- Lien fees
- Warrant fees
- Penalties for late tax reports
- Penalties for incomplete reports or reports in the wrong format
- Penalties for late payment
- Interest charges
- Tax payments

Interest charges

We charge 1% interest on late taxes due on the first of each month. If a due date falls on a weekend or a legal holiday, you may pay the next business day.

No employees during a quarter

You must file a quarterly tax report even if you have no employees during a quarter.

- Electronically: File at esd.wa.gov/file-taxes.
- By mail: Mark the *no payroll* box on your quarterly report.

Notice about data sharing

We may share limited information about your business for economic and labor market analysis, fraud detection, criminal investigation, or compliance and licensing requirements. You can find more information about how this information is used at esd.wa.gov/tax-data-sharing.

Penalty for incomplete or wrong format

Your tax reports must be complete and in the proper format. You will receive a warning letter the first time you submit an incomplete quarterly report or one that is in the wrong format. After that, we will charge a penalty for each additional occurrence within five years.

Penalty for late payment or late report

Every quarter, you must file your tax and wage report on time and make payments by the due date. We charge a \$25 late fee for each late report plus a late payment penalty for overdue taxes, in addition to interest.

Penalty for misrepresentation

If you knowingly give us false information about the payroll tax on your report, we will charge you 10 times the difference between the tax you paid and the tax you should have paid. We will also charge you for the cost of auditing your books and related collection fees.
