



King County Superior Court Security Summary

KCCH Building Entry

- **364,400** people entered KCCH through magnetometer
- **Over 1,400** per day
- **456,817** articles screened via X-ray



MRJC Building Entry

- **282,141** people entered MRJC through magnetometer
- **Over 1,100** per day
- **287,986** articles screened via X-ray



Property Held

- Knives = **4,764**
- Firearms with Permits = **292**
- Misc. (Scissors, tools, etc.) = **9,930**

External Courthouse Security

- Disorderly Conduct/Disturbances = **139** (125 = Sea; 14 = Kent)
- Bomb Threat = **2** (Seattle)
- Criminal Violations = **10** (Seattle - Obstruction, Vandalism, Theft)

Internal Courthouse Security

- Courtroom Alarms Triggered = **156**
- Protection Escorts = **1,462**
- Courtroom stand-by to assure peace = **418**
- Incident Reports Initiated by Courthouse Security = **196**



King County Superior Court Internal Incident Reports (all KCSC locations)

49 incident reports filed by employees, staff, or judicial officers (including Pro Tem and retired judges). These reports include judges contacted on personal phone numbers, judges stalked and/or harassed, threats of violence towards a judge, threats of protests at courthouse, disruptive courtroom behavior, and employee on employee altercations.
