11 immigration status, or place of birth, from any person in the furtherance of providing
12 services in accordance with a contract with King County unless the inquiry or request is
13 required by state or federal law, regulation, or court order or rule, or is necessary for the
14 contractor to effectively provide the services under the contract. The contractor may
15 inquire about or disclose information relating to a person's citizenship, national origin,
16 immigration status, or place of birth for the purpose of determining eligibility for benefits
17 or seeking reimbursement from federal, state, or other third-party payers. When an
18 inquiry about or request for information of the citizenship, national origin, immigration

status, or place of birth is required or for any reason is made, the contractor shall not attempt to coerce a response. All persons to whom the inquiries or requests are made shall be explicitly informed of their right to decline to respond, free from fear or threat of retaliation."

EFFECT prepared by M. Bailey: *The amendment would:*

- *Add "date of birth" to the definition of "personal information" in K.C.C. 2.15.005, and*
- *Add, to the new section that would be added to K.C.C. Chapter 2.15 (Section 2, Subsection B of the proposed ordinance), that contractors may not inquire about or request as part of providing services under a contract with the County about the citizenship, national origin, immigration status, or place of birth of any person unless required by any state or federal law, regulation, or court order or rule. Contractors would be required to inform people of their right to decline to respond, free from fear or threat of retaliation. This language aligns with an existing requirement of county employees in K.C.C. 2.15.010.E.*
