#### Ordinance

- Commits Metro to notifying King County Council, cities of substantial changes
- Commits Metro to submitting service change ordinance
- Authorizes Metro to enter into an agreement for service commitment

- Establishes alignment
- Establishes station locations

Proposes corridor improvements for stations, speed and reliability, bike/pedestrian improvements to advance to design

 Proposes initial service plan

# Draft Locally Preferred Alternative

#### **Passenger Facilities**

- 35 station pairs
- Shelters, lighting, real-time information signs


## **Speed & Reliability**

- Proposed changes could reduce travel times by 25%
- BAT lanes, queue jumps, transit signal priority, station spacing

#### **Access to Transit**

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 Numerous street crossing, bicycle, and sidewalk improvements



#### March 2025

 Received Letters of Support for the Draft Locally Preferred Alternative from both City Councils

#### May 2025

Transmitted ordinance to King County Council

#### August 2025

Submit for Project Rating from the Federal Transit Administration

#### Fall 2025

Begin preliminary design, project delivery partnership discussions with jurisdictions

## Spring 2026

Engage community, property owners in design process
