WHEREAS, King County has secured River Protection Easement for Raging River. (R/W 11 )

ANTHONY J. SCALZO and ALICE SCALZO, Party, of the first part, does hereby, in consideration of one dollar, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, GRANT to the County of King, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Washington, party of the second part, the right to construct and maintain a Gauging Station and install measuring devices along the Right bank of Raging River, on the following described property:

Beginning at the North 1/4 corner of said Section 22; Twp. 24 N. R. 7 E.W.M., thence S. 0°02'19" East 423 feet to the Northeasterly property corner; thence S. 89°25'39" West 294.52 ft. to the easterly bank of the Raging River; thence meandering southerly along the bank of said river to a point which bears S. 89°25'39" West from a point on the Westerly right of way line of Fall City Highway ( Road 1008); thence N. 89°25'39" East 18 feet to a 1/2 inch pipe on the Westerly right of way line of said Road 1008; thence Northeasterly along said line 472.34 feet to a 1/2 inch pipe; thence N. 0°02'19" West 87.72 feet to the true point of beginning.

Also any reasonable access necessary for River Control Work.

BE IT RESOLVED that said River Protection Easement be accepted by King County and the Clerk of the Council be and is hereby authorized to file said River Protection Easement for record in the King County Auditor's Office.
