KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

N.E. 200th Street (139th Ave NE to 144th Avenue N.E.)
144th Avenue N.E. (N.E. 200th Street to N.E. 194th Street)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the King County Council by majority vote, that a road known as N.E. 200th Street and 144th Avenue N.E., be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at a point on the centerline of 139th Ave. NE said point being N. 88°50'35" W. a distance of 141.19 feet from the N.W. corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., thence in an easterly and southerly direction a distance of 2968.41 feet to a terminus on the east line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 3, said terminus being S. 0°14'53" E. a distance of 181.16 feet from the NE corner of said subdivision.

2968.41 ft. = 0.56 Mile

The King County Council herewith finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity and herewith directs the Director of Public Works to make an examination of said road and to report upon same as required by law.
