THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SW 148th St. (Ambaum Blvd. to 1st Ave. S.)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

SW 148th St.

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 19, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., thence easterly a distance of 3239.66 ft. to a terminus at the SE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 19, said terminus also being the intersection of 1st. Ave. S.

3239.66 Ft. = 0.61 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
