IN THE MATTER OF VACATION of a portion of County Road No. 191, and County Road No. 1224.

WHEREAS: A contract was entered into on November 19, 1956, between the United States Government and King County, Washington, relative to the development of the Eagle Gorge Resevoir, Green River, Washington, which in part stated that King County would vacate portions of County Roads numbered 191, 381, 1099 and 1224.

WHEREAS: On November 9, 1959, King County passed Orders of Vacation for County Roads numbered 191, 381 and 1099 together with County Road Survey No. 1044.

WHEREAS: A search of the records reveals that certain portions of County Roads 191 and 1224 apparently were not vacated in accordance with the "Contract" agreement and

\*WHEREAS: The County Council of King County, Washington, considers useless as part of the general road system of King County, those portions of County Roads numbered 191 and 1224 hereinafter more particularly described, NOW THEREFORE

A MOTION is introduced by the County Council that they hereby declare their intention to vacate and abandon for public use that portion of King County Road No. 191 in the NE \( \frac{1}{4} \) of the NW \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Section 9, Twp. 21 North, Range 7 East, W.M. lying within the 200 foot wide strip of land known as Eagle Gorge Project - Railroad Relocation, the total distance being approximately 260 feet; ALSO that portion of King County Road No. 1224 in the N \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Section 9 and the S \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Section 4 all in Twp. 21 N., R. 7 E., W.M. lying also within the 200 foot wide strip of land known as Eagle Grove Project - Railroad Relocation, the total distance being approximately 150 feet and that a hearing on this matter be held on the regular meeting of the County Council on the \( \frac{25 \times }{4} \) day of \( \frac{1}{2} \) 1969, and the Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to post and publish notice thereof pursuant to law and the Director of Public Works is directed to report upon such vacation and abandonment at said hearing.
