

MOTION NO. 87

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

43rd Pl. South (S. 116th St. - 44th Ave. So.)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

43rd Place South

be established not less than 50 feet in width, having 25 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of So. 116th St. in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Twp. 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., said point being 239.85 ft. W'ly of the intersection of So. 116th St. and 44th Ave. So.; thence SE'ly 372.94 ft. to a terminous on the centerline of 44th Ave. So.; said terminous being 363.39 ft. S'ly of the above mentioned intersection.

372.94 Ft. = 0.07 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
