

NOTICE NO. 55

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

S. 212th Street and S. 208th St., (92nd Ave. S. to 108th Ave. S.E.) (Benson Road)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

S. 212th Street

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the North-South Centerline of Sec. 7, Twp. 22 N., R. 5 E., W.M. at a point 1319.65 ft. s'ly of the North 1/4 corner thereof, thence N. 89°54'56"E., a distance of 443.07 ft.; thence on the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 572.96 ft., a distance of 728.46; thence N. 16°04'10"E. a distance of 505.72 ft.; thence on the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 572.96 ft., a distance of 740.72 ft.; thence S. 89°51'30"E. a distance of 967.68 ft. to the NE corner of said Sec. 7, Twp. 22 N., R. 5 E., W.M.; thence S. 88°36'43"E. a distance of 2555.16 ft., to a terminus at the centerline intersection of SE 208th St. and 108th Ave. SE (Benson Road), said centerline intersection being the N. 1/4 cor. of Sec. 8, Twp. 22 N., R. 5 E, W.M., King County, Washington.

5950.81 ft. = 1.13 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
