

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

94th Ave. SW (SW 275th St. to 645' South)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

94th Avenue Southwest

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point in Section 32, Township 22 North, Range 3 East, W.M., said point being the intersection of SW 275th St. and 94th Ave. SW thence in a southerly direction a distance of 644.95 Ft. to a terminus at the intersection of the centerline of 94th Ave. SW with the North line of GLENGARRY PARK as recorded in Volume 87 of Plats, page 81 & 82, Records of King County, Washington.

644.95 Ft. = .122 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
