

MOTION NO. 94

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

S.W. 112th Street (4th Avenue S.W. - 1st Avenue South)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

S.W. 112th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the S.W. corner of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 6, Township 23 North, Range 4, East W.M. Thence along the south line of said Section 6 in an easterly direction a distance of 1328.45 ft. to a terminus at the south east corner of said Section 6, said terminus being the intersection of 1st Avenue South.

1328.45 feet = .252 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
