MOTION NO. 106

WHEREAS, on May 19th, 1969, the County Council of King County, Washington passed Ordinance No. 10, establishing King County Road Improvement District No. 47 (4th Pl. So. from So. 210th to So. 212th Street), and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance directed the Director of the Department of Public Works to proceed with the improvements, and upon determination of the costs, to prepare and file with the Clerk of the King County Council an Assessment Roll for that portion of the entire cost and expense of said improvements to be assessed against the property included within Road Improvement District No. 47, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works has prepared and filed with the Clerk of the King County Council said assessment roll, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: The hearing upon the assessment roll for the improvements in Road Improvement District No. 47 shall be scheduled for November 17, 1969.

SECTION 2: The King County Council will sit as a Board of Equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

SECTION 3: The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to the owner or reputed owner of the property whose name appears thereon, by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owner or reputed owner at the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
