MOTION NO. 384

WHEREAS, the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended, provides for the United States Department of Labor to provide financial assistance to state and local public bodies for experimental and demonstration programs for occupational development and training; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Employment Security Department has entered into contract with the United States Department of Labor for the establishment and operation of a vocational resource center involving alcoholic persons released from residential treatment centers by making available existing community agency services in a manner which will significantly contribute to the rehabilitation and re-employment of such persons, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Employment Security Department is desirous of entering into a subcontract with King County, Washington, to establish and operate the vocational resource center, and

WHEREAS, King County, Washington, through the Cedar Hills Alcoholic Treatment Center, Department of Public Safety, has the capability to establish and operate the vocational resource center with financial assistance entirely funded by the United States Department of Labor through the Washington State Employment Security Department, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That the County Executive is authorized to enter into and execute the necessary subcontract with the Washington State Employment Security Department in the amount to be agreed upon in order to accomplish the statement of work contained in said subcontract; and
