

MOTION NO. 127


WHEREAS the following facts have been shown:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, called for bids for lease of the area at the airport occupied by TEXACO, INC., notice of the same being published in the Sammamish Valley News January 29th and February 5th and 12th, 1969. The successful bidder was TEXACO, INC., who bid \$1,634.00 per year for 11,468 square feet.
2. The lease was prepared and signed by TEXACO, INC., but was not signed for King County prior to the installation of the new form of government under the Home Rule Charter.
3. After examination by the now Property Management Division with the object of negotiating increased rentals it was determined that the lease as originally bid should be granted. The lease was redrafted to reflect the new form of county government and was resigned on behalf of TEXACO, INC., a copy thereof being hereto attached. The original file of the then County Commissioners is attached hereto.
4. It appears that the lease, as redrafted and signed by TEXACO, INC., should be signed on behalf of King County.


NOW THEREFORE,

It is hereby resolved by the King County Council that the King County Executive is authorized and directed to sign and acknowledge a said lease on behalf of King County.
