THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SE 124th Street (132nd Avenue SE to 138th Avenue SE)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

SE 124th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., said point being on the centerline of 132nd Avenue SE, thence S 88° 11' 33" East a distance of 1948.82 feet to a terminus on the centerline of 138th Avenue SE, said terminus being the SE corner of the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said section.

1948.82 Ft. = 0.37 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
