

MOTION NO. 136

1 WHEREAS, a great variety of wildlife is one of America's
2 natural heritages and a symbol of beauty to all people, including
3 citizens of the County of King, State of Washington; and,

4 WHEREAS, wildlife is also recognized as a measure of
5 environmental quality; and,

6 WHEREAS, the increasing amount of pollution, industrial
7 expansion, and other land-development projects are rapidly
8 depleting wildlife populations and destroying the quality of
9 man's environment; and,

10 WHEREAS, the period March 15-21 and the balance of 1970
11 will be observed throughout the Nation as a time to ask all
12 Americans to take stock of their world with the question, "Seen
13 any wildlife lately?"; now, therefore,


14 BE IT MOVED that the County of King, does hereby proclaim
15 March 15-21 as National Wildlife Week and urges all citizens to
16 support this vital conservation observance.
