

MOTION NO. 146

1 WHEREAS, the counties of Pierce and King have entered  
2 into a contract pursuant to the provisions of RCW 86.13 for the  
3 joint administration and financial cooperation in the improve-  
4 ment, confinement and protection of rivers and their banks,  
5 whose waters flowing into and through said counties, work damage  
6 by flooding and otherwise, and

7 WHEREAS, the said contract has as one of its main  
8 objects, the improvement, confinement and protection of the White  
9 River, also known as "Stuck River", and

10 WHEREAS, both Pierce and King Counties have considered  
11 the necessity of the removal of the sand and gravel bar on a  
12 continuing basis in order to protect and confine the channel of  
13 the White River, and

14 WHEREAS, both of said counties have determined to enter  
15 into an agreement with the cities of Algona and Pacific to have  
16 said bar removed, said agreement made pursuant to the statutory  
17 authority granting to counties acting jointly to sell, transfer,  
18 trade, lease or otherwise dispose of property by public or pri-  
19 vate negotiations or sale, as set out in RCW 86.13.100;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council  
21 of King County, Washington, as follows:

22 The County Executive is authorized to execute for and  
23 on behalf of King County an agreement with the cities of Algona  
24 and Pacific for the removal of sand and gravel from an area of  
25 the White (Stuck) River more particularly described in the  
26 agreement.
