3 WHEREAS, the Board of King County Commissioners had
4 determined by Resolution No. 36384, passed on December 9,
5 1968, that it was in the best public interest of the citizens
6 of King County to intervene, as a member of the Washington
7 Parties, in the various Civil Aeronautics Board's route
8 proceedings, and

9 WHEREAS, the County Council, having assumed the legis-
10 lative responsibilities of the Board of King County Commis-
11 sioners in accordance with the King County Home Rule Charter,
12 approved by the voters of King County on November 5, 1968,
13 further determined that it is still in the public interest
14 of the citizens of King County to continue to intervene, as a
15 member of the Washington Parties, in the various Civil Aero-
16 nautics Board's route proceedings named in Resolution No. 36384
17 and in addition the Seattle-Alaska Service, CAB Docket 20826
18 and Seattle/Portland-Reno Nonstop Service, Docket 21136 route
19 proceedings.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of
21 King County, Washington, that:


22 1. The County Executive is authorized to enter into an
23 agreement to further participate financially as a member of
24 the Washington Parties in the Civil Aeronautics Board's Seattle-
25 Alaska Service and Seattle/Portland-Reno Nonstop Service pro-
26 ceedings.

27 2. The financial participation in the Civil Aeronautics
28 Board's proceedings mentioned in paragraph 1, above, will not
29 exceed the sum of \$4,375, which is estimated to be required
30 towards the successful completion of said proceedings. However,
