THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

228th Ave. NE Ext. (NE 8th St. - Redmond-Fall City Road)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as 228th Avenue NE

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the SE corner of Sec. 28, Twp. 25 N., R. 6 E.W.M. said corner being the intersection of NE 8th St. and 228th Avenue NE, thence north-westerly a distance of 18,020.33 feet to a terminus on the centerline of the Redmond-Fall City Road. Said terminus being N 78°31'09" West a distance of 2266.07 feet from the east ¼ corner of Sec. 17, Twp. 25 N., R. 6 E.W.M.

18,020.33 Feet = 3.413 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
