THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

140th Avenue SE (SE 200th Street to Petrovitsky Road)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as 140th Avenue SE

be established not less than 100 feet in width, having 50 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point of intersection of the centerline's of SE 200th Street and 140th Avenue SE in the N 1/2 of Sec. 3, Twp. 22 N., R. 5 E., W.M., King County, Washington; said point bearing N 01°02'10" E. a distance of 30.00 feet from the center of Sec. 3; Thence in a NE'ly direction a distance of 8143.21 feet to a point of terminus on the centerline of Petrovitsky Road as revised and established May 28, 1962; said point of terminus bearing N 02°28'31" E. a distance of 204.78 feet from the south 1/4 corner of Sec. 27, Twp. 23 N., R. 5 E., W.M., King County, Washington.

8143.21 Feet or 1.542 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
