

MOTION NO. 11257

WHEREAS, Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of King County to provide the necessary measures to prevent crime and to insure the greater safety of the people of King County, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the County Council and the County Executive to continue to improve and strengthen the public safety capabilities of King County, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to have an administrative assistant for law enforcement coordination to work with and assist the local governments in King County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That an application be made to the Law and Justice Planning Office for a grant in the amount of \$32,750 for the purpose of establishing a position of administrative assistant for law enforcement coordination on the County Executive's staff.
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and to file such application with the Law and Justice Planning Office, to execute such contracts as are required by said office, and to act as the authorized correspondent.
3. That the said purpose is in accordance with the public safety policy and program of King County.

4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
