

1 A MOTION relating to the petition by Metropolitan Transit
2 Corporation to terminate services in certain areas of King
3 County.

4 WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transit Corporation, a Subsidiary
5 of Chromalloy American Corporation, has petitioned the Washington
6 Public Utility and Transit Commission for permission to
7 permanently suspend services to extensive areas within King County,
8 and specifically, the cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton and Tukwila,
9 and,


10 WHEREAS, it has been determined that regular commuters, the

12 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that public
13 transportation is essential to the citizens of King County,

15 that the Washington Public Utility and Transit Commission hold
16 Metropolitan Transit Corporation's request in abeyance until such
17 time as transportation studies can be completed and all
18 possibilities of providing this vital service are explored.


