THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

South 272nd Street (FAI 5 to 42nd Avenue South)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as South 272nd Street

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point which bears N 87°32'04" W a distance of 254.05 feet from the NE corner of Sec. 33, Twp. 22 N., R. 4 E.W.M. said point being Eng. Sta. 40+85.85 on the centerline of South 272nd Street at the state right of way line of FAI 5 as surveyed by King County Survey No. 33-22-4-16; Thence in an easterly direction 2906.67 feet to a terminus at the intersection of 42nd Avenue South, said terminus being the north 1/4 corner of Sec. 34, Twp. 22 N., R. 4 E., W.M.

2906.67 Feet = 0.55 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
