THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING: 122nd Avenue S.E. (S.E. 48th St. to Newport Way)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road know as 122nd Avenue S.E.

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of S.E. 48th St, said point also being on the Southline of Section 16, Township 24 N., Range 5 East, W.M. N. 88°36'12" W. a distance of 450.02 feet from South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 16, tence in a Northerly and Northeasterly direction a distance of 2,306.44 ft. to a terminus, on the centerline of Newport Way, said terminus being Engineering Station 45+51.45 as surveyed by King County Survey No. 16-24-5-10.

2,306.44 ft. = 0.44 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
