THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

NE 155th Street  
(84th Avenue NE to Simonds Road)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

NE 155th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:


Beginning at the West 1/4 Corner of Section 18, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 1087.93 feet to a terminus on the centerline of Simonds Road said terminus being N. 88°01'36"W. 1364.34 feet from the center of said Section 18.

1087.93 feet = 0.206 mile


The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
