A MOTION relating to King County Policy for the Implementation of Chapter 84.34 RCW - Open Space, Agricultural and Timberlands - Current Use Assessment

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Motion, recognizes that it is in the best interest of King County to maintain, preserve, conserve or otherwise continue in existence adequate open space lands. The application of current use taxing practices to some property in King County will necessarily result in a reduction of income to the County with a proportionate reduction of services, unless other sources of revenue are available. Since the prime source of funds to provide county services is the property tax, any action which would reduce income or change rates should only be undertaken after a comprehensive review of the consequences.

In order to insure consistent and fair treatment for applicants, and to reasonably measure and maximize the public benefit as against potential loss of revenue, the Council deems it necessary to administer this act based on guidelines of a County-initiated plan for open space lands, rather than merely by reaction to a variety of unrelated individual applications.

Therefore, it shall be the Council's policy to require as a condition precedent to the approval of any application filed for classification of land as "Open Space Land", "Farm and Agricultural Land" or "Timberland" as defined in Chapter 84.34 RCW that such lands be designated as open space land by the official comprehensive plan adopted by the County and in the case of "Farm and Agricultural Land" or "Timberland" be zoned accordingly.

The King County Council recognizes that few properties presently meet this condition; however, the County has an adopted comprehensive plan which includes a category title, "Open Space" and describes open space as Major Urban Parks --- Golf Courses, Agriculture and Flood Control, Forest, Watershed and Wilderness, Inland Waterways and Lakes and Institutions. This plan for open space is being reviewed to determine what changes are required to be consistent with the purposes and procedures of Chapter 84.34 RCW. A revised plan will be in effect by January 1, 1972, which is the

earliest date applications may be made under RCW 84.34.020 (1) (a). The County comprehensive plan shall continue to treat Farm and Timberland as open space lands and all applications shall be processed administratively under RCW 84.34.020 (1) (a). Lands not included in the comprehensive open space plan may be added by amending the comprehensive plan as provided in Ordinance #00263. Lands already indicated as part of the open space plan shall be processed in the same manner as reclassifications under Ordinance #00263 and, for assessment purposes, shall be classified as "open space", "Farm and Agricultural Lands" or "Timberland" as set forth in the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to RCW 84.34.140.
