KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SE 290TH STREET (E. H. Evenson Road No. 410)
(188th Avenue SE to 196th Avenue SE)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREEAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of
King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as
SE 290th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of
such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 6,
Twp. 21 N., Rge. 6 E., W.M.; thence S.1°03'00"E.
along the North-South centerline of said Sec. 6, a
distance of 781.64 feet to the true point of beginning,
said point being on the centerline of SE 290th St.
(E. H. Evenson Road No. 410) at the intersection of
188th Avenue SE; thence in an Easterly direction a
distance of 2750.96 feet to a terminus on the center-
line of SE 288th Place at the intersection of 196th
Avenue SE, said terminus being S.0°57'38"E. a distance
of 89.95 feet from the Northeast corner of Sec. 6,
Twp. 21 N., Rge. 6 E., W.M.

2750.96 feet = 0.52 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said
roadway along the course and description set forth is a public
necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public
Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as
required by law.
