2 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, attached hereto,  
3 which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on December 2, 1970,  
4 regarding the application for an Unclassified Use Permit petitioned  
5 by the Red Samm Mining Co., designated by the Department of Planning  
6 No. 204-70-P and the Council does concur with the recommendations  
7 contained therein with the following addition: To RECOMMENDATIONS  
8 on Page 7 of above report - "3. The requirements for fencing,  
9 recontouring and preventing siltation of Honey Dew Creek are  
10 intended to rectify conditions caused by past operations at the  
11 site; and these requirements should not be construed by the applicant  
12 as committing the County in any manner on the issue of a new  
13 unclassified use permit for the property."
