WHEREAS, the following facts have been shown;

1. The City of Enumclaw has applied for a permit to lay a ten (10) inch cast iron water pipe across County Park property near Enumclaw Washington. This pipe is an integral part of the City's water supply system.

2. The application has been investigated and approved by the Department of Parks.

3. It appears that it would be for the best interest of the County to grant the application subject to the terms and conditions of the City's existing water pipe line Franchise No. 249.

It is hereby resolved by the King County Council that the County Executive is authorized and directed to sign and deliver said permit on behalf of King County.
